famous Tengboche Monastery, one of the most significant spiritual sites in the Khumbu region, where trekkers can witness

the daily rituals of Buddhist monks with the backdrop of towering mountains.

The highlight of the trek is reaching the Everest View Hotel, one of the highest hotels in the world, from where you can enjoy

panoramic views of Mount Everest, Lhotse, and other peaks. The trek is not just about the mountains; it also provides a rich cultural experience, allowing trekkers to interact with the warm and hospitable Sherpa people, learn about their traditions,

and experience their way of life.

The Everest View Trek is moderately challenging, suitable for trekkers of all ages and fitness levels, provided they are

prepared for some uphill climbs and the effects of altitude. The journey typically takes around 7 to 10 days, making it an

excellent choice for those looking to experience the grandeur of the Himalayas in a relatively short period.

Itinerary

Day 1 : Departure to Lukla Airport (2860m/9383 ft.), Commence trek to Phakding (Duration: 3 Hours)

Have morning breakfast at the hotel and check out Get ready for the Lukla flight rive to Kathmandu domestic airport along with our professional Sherpa guide Reach at the Lukla airport within 40 minutes of flight duration. Witness the panoramic views of the great Himalayas. Brief introduction with the porter and the trek begins towards Cheplung village. On the way to this village, enjoy the spectacular view of Mt. Khumbila. Enjoy the views of the extreme whitewater river, the Dudh Koshi. Phakding, this territory is standing along the divine Dudh Koshi river which is bounded by high hills.

Day 2: Trek to Namche Bazaar (3440m/11,290 ft) (Distance Covering: 10-12km, Duration: 6 Hours)

Morning breakfast Sherpa style at Phakding and departure Passing through smaller villages like Benkar, Monjo and Jorsele on the way to Namche Bazaar Visit Sagarmatha National Park while trekking forward Being captivated with the dense forest decorated with blue-pine, cedar and Rhododendron flowers the trail leads up to Namche Bazaar Take rest and enjoy dinner Night stay at Namche Bazaar

Day 3: Trek to Tengboche (3867m/12,687 ft) (Distance Covering: 10-11 km, Duration: 5 Hours)

Morning breakfast at Namche Bazaar and departure The trek commences along the Dudh Koshi River, silvery vista of Mt. Everest, Lhotse Explore the glowing sight of Mt. Everest, Ama Dablam, Thamserku and other peaks from the top of the Tengboche Monastery Visit the legendary Tengboche Monastery Have a look towards the sunsets Enjoy dinner and nightlife with Sherpas Night stay at Tengboche guest house

Day 4: Back to Namche Bazaar (Duration: 6 Hours)

Morning breakfast at Tengboche Stepping down towards Phungi Thanka and passing through Kyangjuma, we reach back to Namche Detect the local people's customs and experience their hospitality Meet the people and know their culture and behavior Enjoy dinner and night stay at Namche guest house

Day 5: Back to Lukla (Duration: 5 and half Hours)

Today is the last day of our adventure and we close our memorable journey The trail passes through bumping bridges and beautiful villages filled with Chortens, Prayer flags, Mani-stone and small Gompas Re-enjoy the stunning views of snow-coated peaks, forests covered with wild moorland, Rhododendron flowers and pines Enjoy the evening with your porters and trekking guide at Lukla Dinner and night stay at Lukla guest house

Day 6: Flight back to Kathmandu Domestic Airport

Morning breakfast at Lukl Around 40 minutes of your flight, you will reach back to Kathmandu Drive to the hotel at Kathmandu and hotel check-in Take time to rest and explore around Thamel, the touristic center of Kathmandu For dinner, we organize a special farewell dinner with a live Nepali culture show Night stay at the hotel in Kathmandu
